1 Strike lines 38 to 48, inclusive, and insert the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "(e) On and after August 1, 2009, upon receipt of a written request to
4 access data maintained under this section, by a nonprofit organization
5 that is exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
6 Revenue Code of 1986, or any subsequent corresponding internal
7 revenue code of the United States, as from time to time amended, and
8 that is organized and operated for educational purposes, the
9 Department of Education shall provide such data to such requesting
10 party not later than sixty days after such request, provided such
11 requesting party shall be responsible for the reasonable cost of such
12 request. The Department of Information Technology shall monitor the
13 calculation of such fees charged for access to or copies of such records
14 to ensure that such fees are reasonable and consistent with those
15 charged by other state agencies. The Department of Education shall

16 respond to written requests under this section in the order in which
17 they are received."
