"AN ACT CONCERNING THE INCLUSION OF STUDENTS ON LOCAL AND REGIONAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION."

1 Strike lines 22 to 27, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(b) Each local or regional board of education that maintains a
4 public high school shall have at least two students serve on such board
5 of education as nonvoting members. Such students shall be selected
6 from among such high schools located under the jurisdiction of such
7 board. The total number of students from each high school shall be
8 determined by the local or regional board of education, in accordance
9 with the provisions of this section, and the students shall be selected
10 through a student election or in another manner prescribed by such
11 board of education."

12 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
13 internal references accordingly:

14 "Sec. 501. Section 10-66b of the general statutes is repealed and the
15 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2009*):

16 The operation and management of any regional educational service
17 center shall be the responsibility of the board of such center to be
18 composed of at least one member from each participating board of
19 education, selected by such board of education. The board of the
20 regional educational service center may designate from its
21 membership an executive board which shall have such powers as the
22 board of the regional educational service center may delegate and
23 which are consistent with this part. The term of office of members of
24 the board of the regional educational service center shall not exceed
25 four years. Members of the board of the regional educational service
26 center shall receive no compensation for services rendered as such, but
27 may be reimbursed for necessary expenses in the course of their duties.
28 The director of the regional educational service center shall serve as
29 the executive agent of the board of the regional educational service
30 center. Each board of a regional educational service center that
31 maintains an interdistrict magnet high school shall have at least two
32 students serve on such board as nonvoting members. Such students
33 shall be selected from among students who attend an interdistrict
34 magnet high school maintained by such regional educational service
35 center. The total number of such students shall be determined by the
36 board, in accordance with the provisions of this section, and the
37 students shall be selected through a student election or in another
38 manner prescribed by such board."
