**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE FAIR PRICING OF GASOLINE."**

1      After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2      internal references accordingly:

3      "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) As used in this section:

4      (1) "Employee" means a person engaged in service to an employer in  
5      a business of his or her employer;

6      (2) "Employee organization" shall have the same meaning as in  
7      section 5-270 of the general statutes;

8      (3) "Labor organization" shall have the same meaning as in section  
9      31-101 of the general statutes; and

10      (4) "Wage" means compensation due to an employee by reason of  
11      his employment.

12      (b) The Labor Commissioner, or his or her designee, shall study the  
13      wages paid to employees in each collective bargaining unit, employee

14 organization or labor organization in the state. Such study shall collect  
15 wage information as it relates to job title, job duties, employee years of  
16 service and the area of the state in which the employer is located, and  
17 shall evaluate the consistency of wages paid state-wide.

18 (c) On or before January 1, 2010, the commissioner shall submit a  
19 report of his or her findings to the joint standing committee of the  
20 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to labor and  
21 public employees, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of  
22 the general statutes."
