"AN ACT CONCERNING THE FAIR PRICING OF GASOLINE."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Commissioner of
4 Consumer Protection, within available appropriations, shall conduct a
5 study of gasoline prices in the state. The study shall (1) assess the
6 impact on such prices that would result from a prohibition of any
7 gasoline pricing system whereby a person engaged in the business of
8 furnishing gasoline to a reseller or retail gas station in this state
9 determines the price paid for such gasoline based on the geographic
10 location of such reseller or retail gas station; and (2) determine if the
11 prohibition of such gasoline pricing system would result in an increase
12 in the price of gasoline in the state outside of Fairfield County.

13 (b) Not later than January 1, 2010, the commissioner shall report the
14 findings and recommendations of the study to the joint standing
15 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters

16 relating to general law in accordance with the provisions of section 11-
17 4a of the general statutes. If the commissioner determines that the
18 prohibition of such gasoline pricing system would not result in an
19 increase in the price of gasoline in the state outside of Fairfield County,
20 the commissioner shall recommend that legislation be enacted
21 prohibiting such gasoline pricing system."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
