**"AN ACT CONCERNING BENEFICIAL REUSE, RECYCLING,
ILLEGAL DUMPING AND MUNICIPAL DEMONSTRATION
PROJECTS."**

1 Strike sections 2 to 6, inclusive, in their entirety and renumber the
2 remaining sections and internal references accordingly

3 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
4 internal references accordingly:

5 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2009*) Each local and regional
6 board of education shall develop and implement a recycling plan at
7 each school under the board's jurisdiction. Such plan shall include, but
8 not be limited to, (1) the provision of a sufficient number of recycling
9 receptacles and simple signage with instructions on proper recycling;
10 (2) a requirement for appropriate disposal of recyclable materials by
11 students and all school personnel; and (3) training of custodial staff for
12 the appropriate segregation of recyclable materials from municipal
13 solid waste at the point of collection to container storage pending

14 removal by a licensed hauler. Local and regional boards of education
15 may utilize the services of local recycling coordinators or regional
16 recycling educators that are experienced in teaching the principles of
17 recycling. Local and regional school districts may join together in
18 issuing a request for proposals, from time to time, for the
19 transportation of recyclable items to ensure best pricing. Such request
20 for proposals may require compensation to the district or districts from
21 the sale of recyclable items to support the cost of student activities.
22 Items required to be recycled pursuant to this section shall be the items
23 designated as items that are generated and discarded at the school and
24 required to be recycled by the Commissioner of Environmental
25 Protection in regulations adopted in accordance with the provisions of
26 subsection (a) of section 22a-241b of the general statutes. Such items
27 shall be recycled at the facility designated by the town in which the
28 school is located pursuant to the provisions of section 22a-220a of the
29 general statutes, if the town has so designated such a facility."
