1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Ballroom Polka, written  
4 by Connecticut native, Ray Henry Mocariski, shall be the state polka.

5 Sec. 502. Section 10-29a of the general statutes is amended by adding  
6 subdivision (53) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

7 (NEW) (53) The Governor shall proclaim the month of September of  
8 each year to be Public Safety Awareness Month to heighten public  
9 awareness of public safety issues. Suitable exercises shall be held in the  
10 State Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor designates for the

11 observance of the month. Each of the district headquarters and troop  
12 barracks of the Division of State Police within the Department of  
13 Public Safety shall fly the flag that represents the National Law  
14 Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington D.C. in front of such  
15 headquarters or barracks for each day of said month."
