**"AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE  
CONNECTICUT TOWN CLERKS."**

1      After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2      internal references accordingly:

3      "Sec. 501. Section 1-94 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4      following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

5      (a) A lobbyist shall register with the Office of State Ethics pursuant  
6      to this part if it or he:

7      (1) Receives or agrees to receive compensation or reimbursement for  
8      actual expenses, or both, in a combined amount of two thousand  
9      dollars or more in a calendar year for lobbying, whether that receipt of  
10     compensation or reimbursement or agreement to receive such  
11     compensation or reimbursement is solely for lobbying or the lobbying  
12     is incidental to that person's regular employment; or

13     (2) Makes or incurs an obligation to make expenditures of two

14 thousand dollars or more in a calendar year for lobbying.

15 (b) The requirements of subsection (a) of this section shall not be  
16 deemed to apply to any religious organization, provided any lobbyist  
17 retained by any such religious organization shall be required to  
18 register with the Office of State Ethics if such lobbyist would otherwise  
19 be required to register pursuant to the provisions of subsection (a) of  
20 this section."
