**"AN ACT CONCERNING PRIORITY FOR SUBSIDIZED HOUSING
BY ELDERLY OR DISABLED PERSONS WITH EMERGENCY
MEDICAL CONDITIONS."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2009*) Each housing authority
4 and each nonprofit or for-profit organization operating assisted
5 housing, as defined in subdivision (3) of subsection (a) of section 8-30g
6 of the general statutes, shall establish a written policy that provides the
7 highest priority in transfer of tenants to another dwelling unit of the
8 authority or organization to tenants in households that include a
9 person who is elderly or disabled and prevented from full use of the
10 dwelling unit because of a permanent medical condition and the
11 physical characteristics of the dwelling unit. Such policy shall include
12 (1) provisions describing coordination of transfers with new tenant
13 selection, and (2) development of a form for certification by a licensed
14 medical practitioner that the medical condition of the tenant

15 necessitates transfer to a dwelling unit that does not include the
16 physical characteristics of the dwelling unit in which the tenant
17 resides."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
