"AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE PROVISIONS OF THE BUDGET CONCERNING EDUCATION, AUTHORIZING STATE GRANT COMMITMENTS FOR SCHOOL BUILDING PROJECTS, AND MAKING CHANGES TO THE STATUTES CONCERNING SCHOOL BUILDING PROJECTS AND OTHER EDUCATION STATUTES."

1 Strike section 48 in its entirety and replace the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 48. Subsection (a) of section 10-145 of the general statutes, as
4 amended by section 15 of public act 09-1 of the June 19 special session,
5 is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
6 *from passage*):

7 (a) No teacher, supervisor, administrator, special service staff
8 member or school superintendent, except as provided for in section 10-
9 157, shall be employed in any of the schools of any local or regional
10 board of education unless such person possesses an appropriate state
11 certificate, nor shall any such person be entitled to any salary unless
12 such person can produce such certificate dated previous to or the first

13 day of employment, except as provided for in section 10-157; provided
14 nothing herein contained shall be construed to prevent the board of
15 education from prescribing qualifications additional to those
16 prescribed by the regulations of the State Board of Education and
17 provided nothing herein contained shall be construed to prevent any
18 local or regional board of education from contracting with a licensed
19 drivers' school approved by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles for
20 the behind-the-wheel instruction of a driver instruction course, to be
21 given by driving instructors licensed by the Department of Motor
22 Vehicles. No person shall be employed in any of the schools of any
23 local or regional board of education as a substitute teacher unless such
24 person holds a bachelor's degree, except that (1) for the school year
25 commencing July 1, 2009, such requirement shall not apply to those
26 persons employed by a local or regional board of education in the
27 same assignment for ten or fewer school days, and (2) for the school
28 year commencing July 1, 2009, and each school year thereafter, those
29 towns with a population of less than thirty thousand, or in the case of a
30 regional school district, the Commissioner of Education may waive
31 such requirement for good cause upon the request of a superintendent
32 of school."
