1 Strike lines 5404 to 5408, inclusive, and insert the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "(g) There shall be an executive director of the Latino and Puerto
4 Rican Affairs Commission. Candidates for such executive director
5 position shall be interviewed jointly by members of the commission
6 and the Joint Committee on Legislative Management. Such executive
7 director shall be selected by the Joint Committee on Legislative
8 Management from two candidates provided to the Joint Committee on
9 Legislative Management by members of the commission. In selecting
10 between the two candidates, the Joint Committee on Legislative
11 Management may conduct a background check on such candidates.
12 Any other necessary staff shall be employed by the Joint Committee on
13 Legislative Management. The commission shall have no other
14 authority over staffing or personnel matters."

15 Strike lines 5617 to 5621, inclusive, and insert the following in lieu
16 thereof:

17 "(f) There shall be an executive director of the African American
18 Affairs Commission. Candidates for such executive director position
19 shall be interviewed jointly by members of the commission and the
20 Joint Committee on Legislative Management. Such executive director
21 shall be selected by the Joint Committee on Legislative Management
22 from two candidates provided to the Joint Committee on Legislative
23 Management by members of the commission. In selecting between the
24 two candidates, the Joint Committee on Legislative Management may
25 conduct a background check on such candidates. Any other necessary
26 staff shall be employed by the Joint Committee on Legislative
27 Management. The commission shall have no other authority over
28 staffing or personnel matters."

78 two candidates provided to the Joint Committee on Legislative

79 Management by members of the commission. In selecting between the
80 two candidates, the Joint Committee on Legislative Management may
81 conduct a background check on such candidates. Any other necessary
82 staff shall be employed by the Joint Committee on Legislative
83 Management. The commission shall have no other authority over
84 staffing or personnel matters."
