"AN ACT CONCERNING A DEFICIT MITIGATION PLAN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2010."

1 Strike section 3 in its entirety and renumber sections and internal
2 references accordingly

3 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
4 internal references accordingly:

5 "Sec. 501. Section 3-69a of the general statutes is repealed and the
6 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

7 [(a) (1) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, the funds received
8 under this part, excluding the proceeds from the sale of property
9 deposited in the Special Abandoned Property Fund in accordance with
10 section 3-62h, shall be deposited in the General Fund.]

11 [(2)] (a) For the fiscal [year] years ending June 30, 2006, to June 30,
12 2009, inclusive, and for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, and each
13 fiscal year thereafter, a portion of the funds received under this part

14 shall, upon deposit in the General Fund, be credited to the Citizens'
15 Election Fund established in section 9-701 as follows: (A) For the fiscal
16 year ending June 30, 2006, seventeen million dollars, (B) for the fiscal
17 year ending June 30, 2007, sixteen million dollars, (C) for the fiscal year
18 ending June 30, 2008, seventeen million three hundred thousand
19 dollars, and (D) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, and each fiscal
20 year thereafter, the amount deposited for the preceding fiscal year,
21 adjusted in accordance with any change in the consumer price index
22 for all urban consumers for such preceding fiscal year, as published by
23 the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics. The
24 State Treasurer shall determine such adjusted amount not later than
25 thirty days after the end of such preceding fiscal year. For the fiscal
26 years ending June 30, 2010, and June 30, 2011, the cash portion of all
27 funds received under this part, including the proceeds from the sale of
28 property, shall be deposited in the General Fund, except as provided in
29 section 3-62h.

30 (b) All costs incurred in the administration of this part, except as
31 provided in section 3-62h and subsection (a) of this section, and all
32 claims allowed under this part shall be paid from the General Fund.

33 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
34 chapter 157 of the general statutes and any regulations concerning the
35 Citizens' Election Program, for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2010,
36 and June 30, 2011, said program shall be inoperative and have no
37 effect.

38 Sec. 503. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
39 section 9-701 of the general statutes, the unexpended balance of funds
40 in the Citizens' Election Fund shall be transferred from said fund and
41 credited to the resources of the General Fund in fiscal year ending June
42 30, 2010."
