Subject: Endorsement of House Bill 6611, "An Act Concerning Composite Motor Vehicles"

Dear State Senator/Representative:

The Connecticut Council of Car Clubs (4C's) is an association of approximately 35 car clubs in Connecticut. The 4C's membership also consists of individual automotive hobbyists. The 4C's Board of Directors are all volunteers.

The 4C's endorses House Bill 6611, which would allow a composite motor vehicle to be registered as the model year the body of the vehicle most closely resembles. This proposed bill will facilitate the use of vintage equipment consistent with the historic period the vehicle is meant to recreate. Therefore, allowing the composite vehicle to be registered as the model year the vehicle most closely resembles will improve the historic significance of the vehicle being recreated. It is noted that several other states currently allow composite motor vehicles to be registered as the year the vehicle most closely resembles.
