**Statement of the Connecticut Clean Energy Fund Regarding Raised Senate Bill
203 An Act Permitting Condominium Associations To Benefit From Clean Energy
Fund Programs.**

The Connecticut Clean Energy Fund's (CCEF) current program structure provides opportunities to a variety of customer and market segments throughout the state. When funding is available, financial support is offered to all customers within the two electric distribution companies service territories. However, currently the CCEF's pipeline (demand) far exceeds our current funding streams. While condominium associations and tenants are "eligible" to apply under CCEF's current program structure, we recognize the challenges associated with specific project scenarios. For example, while a condominium association may consider renewable distributed generation for the common areas, thus providing value to all dwellers, individual owners typically need to research and understand any special provisions by the Association to be able to alter the existing structures. This may be a matter better addressed by individual condominium associations. The CCEF would be glad to work with individual condominium associations or a conglomerate to establish a method to further support renewable energy.
