The Committee on Human Services reported through REP. WALKER of the 93rd Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

## **AN ACT CONCERNING AMENDMENTS TO THE MEDICAID STATE PLAN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 17b-28g of the 2010 supplement to the general  
2 statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof  
3 (*Effective from passage*):

4 The Commissioner of Social Services shall submit written notice and  
5 a copy of any proposed amendment to the Medicaid state plan to the  
6 joint standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance  
7 of matters related to human services and appropriations not less than  
8 ten calendar days prior to submission of such amendment to the  
9 federal government.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

**sHB 5068**

***AN ACT CONCERNING AMENDMENTS TO THE MEDICAID STATE PLAN.***

**SUMMARY:**

The law requires the social services commissioner to notify the Human Services and Appropriations committees before submitting a proposed Medicaid state plan amendment to the federal government for approval. This bill requires (1) the notice to be in writing and (2) the commissioner to submit a copy of the amendment, as well. He must do both at least 10 days before submitting the proposed amendment for federal approval.
