House Joint Resolution No. 20

The Committee on Judiciary reported through REP. LAWLOR of the 99th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the joint resolution ought to be adopted.

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CLAIMS COMMISSIONER TO GRANT AN AWARD TO CARL J. DUNST, PH.D. ON HIS CLAIM AGAINST THE STATE.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That the recommendation of the Claims Commissioner, file number
- 2 21975 of said commissioner, that an award of nine thousand dollars,
- 3 payable from the appropriation to The University of Connecticut
- 4 Health Center, be granted to Carl J. Dunst, Ph.D. on his claim against
- 5 the state in excess of seven thousand five hundred dollars, is accepted
- 6 and that payment of said amount to said claimant is ordered.

Explanation
