Substitute Senate Bill No. 214

*Senate, March 25, 2010*

The Committee on Public Safety and Security reported through SEN. STILLMAN of the 20th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

***AN ACT NAMING THE STATE MILITARY TRAINING FACILITY CAMP NIAN TIC.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective January 6, 2011*) The state military
- 2 training facility in Niantic shall be named Camp Niantic.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>January 6, 2011</i>	New section

**Municipal Impact:** None

**Explanation**

Since a name change for the facility is already anticipated with the upcoming election of the new governor, there will be no fiscal impact in FY 11. To the extent that there is a newly elected governor in 2015 and the Camp Niantic name is permanent, there would be savings of less than \$1,000 to the available federal funds as a result of no changes to the signage and office supplies on the facility's property. There would also be savings of approximately \$5,000 in FY 15 to the Transportation Fund as a result of no changes to directional highway and street signs referring to the facility.

**The Out Years**

There will be minimal periodic savings to the Federal Funds and the Transportation Fund.

This bill changes the name of the state military training facility in Niantic, currently called Camp Rell, to Camp Niantic. Under current practice, the facility is named after the sitting governor.
