The Quinnipiac Chamber of Commerce supports SB-95, AN ACT PRESERVING GOOD CAUSE FOR LATE FILING OF CERTAIN UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION APPEALS.

This is a common sense measure that will help relieve Connecticut's small employers from fines associated with paperwork violations. Many small employers with two employees or less do not retain payroll companies to process wage reports and may inadvertently neglect to file, particularly in quarters where no wages were paid.

Where the failure to file is clearly unintentional, the state Department of Labor should be permitted to waive the fine. It is small issues like this that can truly frustrate small employers who try to comply with Connecticut's laws and regulations. We therefore urge your support for this measure.
