AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF SEAT SAFETY BELTS ON SCHOOL BUSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Commissioner of Motor
2 Vehicles, in consultation with the Commissioner of Education, shall
3 conduct a study of the feasibility of requiring each school bus that is
4 model year 2012 or newer to be equipped with lap/shoulder (3-point)
5 seat safety belts. Such study shall include, but not be limited to, a
6 consideration of safety issues and the cost to municipalities of such
7 requirement.

8 (b) Not later than October 1, 2010, the Commissioner of Motor
9 Vehicles shall submit a report on its findings, with any
10 recommendations for legislation, to the joint standing committees of
11 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
12 transportation, education and appropriations and the budgets of state
13 agencies, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
14 general statutes.
