**AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE MILLIMAN REPORT'S
RECOMMENDATIONS TO ACHIEVE COST SAVINGS IN THE HUSKY
PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to implement certain
- 2 recommendations of the report prepared by Milliman Inc. in May, 2009
- 3 to achieve cost savings in the HUSKY program, including, but not
- 4 limited to: (1) Recovering fifty million dollars in over payments from
- 5 managed care organizations, (2) replacing sealed bids with negotiated
- 6 bids, (3) conducting an annual audit of the program, (4) implementing
- 7 primary care case management state wide, and (5) providing primary
- 8 care case management to children in the HUSKY B program and
- 9 members of the Charter Oak Health Plan.

To implement the Milliman Report's recommendations to achieve cost savings in the HUSKY program.
