AN ACT CONCERNING THE AGE OF JUVENILE JURISDICTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that the age of
- 2 juvenile jurisdiction be limited to children under sixteen years of age
- 3 until January 1, 2012, and provide that the age of juvenile jurisdiction
- 4 include children sixteen years of age on and after January 1, 2012, and
- 5 children seventeen years of age on and after July 1, 2013.

Statement of Purpose:

To delay implementation of the increase in the age of juvenile jurisdiction.
