**AN ACT CONCERNING THE MILITARY FACILITY CONSTRUCTION
OR ACQUISITION PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 27-45 of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2010*):

3 In towns in which one or more military [companies] units are
4 located, suitable [armories] facilities for the use of such [companies]
5 units may be built or [purchased] acquired by the state in accordance
6 with [the] military needs and as recommended by the Adjutant
7 General. [from time to time.] The Adjutant General shall prepare and
8 submit to the General Assembly [an armory] a military facility
9 construction or [purchase] acquisition program which shall be
10 considered the policy of the state and shall be the basis for establishing
11 priority in the appropriation of state money for new construction or
12 the [purchase of armories,] acquisition of facilities, including buildings,
13 [or] land or interests therein for military purposes. [, and a copy of
14 such report shall be furnished to the Commissioner of Public Works
15 and the State Properties Review Board.] The [armory] military facility
16 construction or acquisition program shall be submitted to the

17 Governor on or before the first day of January in the odd-numbered
18 years. A copy of such [report] program shall be submitted to the
19 Commissioner of Public Works, the State Properties Review Board and
20 the appropriate committees of the General Assembly. [for their
21 information.] All state contracts [for buildings or purchasing] to
22 acquire buildings, land or interests therein for military purposes shall
23 be made by the Commissioner of Public Works, who [shall have power
24 to purchase land and build armories] may acquire such property by
25 purchase or in the manner set forth in subsection (b) of section 13a-73,
26 subject to the provisions of section 4b-23. Any reassessment of
27 compensation awarded by the commissioner shall be made in
28 accordance with the procedure set forth in section 13a-76. The
29 Comptroller shall draw [his] an order on the Treasurer for such sums
30 as are necessary to pay [bills contracted by said commissioner for the
31 purposes aforesaid] the expenses incurred by the commissioner in
32 making acquisitions under this section, within the limits of [the]
33 appropriations [made] or available funds. [; and the state is authorized
34 to take any land said commissioner deems necessary for the purpose of
35 locating permanent armories, as provided in section 48-12.]

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
