**AN ACT AUTHORIZING MUNICIPALITIES TO JOIN IN STATE  
CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF SERVICES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 4a-53 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2010*):

3 (a) The Commissioner of Administrative Services may join with  
4 federal agencies, other state governments, political subdivisions of this  
5 state or nonprofit organizations in cooperative purchasing plans when  
6 the best interests of the state would be served thereby.

7 (b) The Commissioner of Administrative Services, in conjunction  
8 with the Department of Environmental Protection and within available  
9 appropriations, shall make known to the chief executive officer of each  
10 municipality the existence of cooperative plans for the purchase of  
11 recycled paper.

12 (c) Any contract for the purchase of services by a state agency may  
13 include a provision requiring the contractor to offer the same services  
14 to municipalities at the same cost set forth in the contract with the

15 state.
