**AN ACT CONCERNING EXPANSION OF THE LIVERY LICENSE  
EXEMPTION TO INCLUDE COMMUNITY-BASED REGIONAL  
TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR THE VISUALLY IMPAIRED.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 13b-101 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2010*):

3 The term "motor vehicle in livery service" includes every motor  
4 vehicle used by any person, association, limited liability company or  
5 corporation which represents itself to be in the business of transporting  
6 passengers for hire, except (1) any motor bus and any taxicab operated  
7 under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by the  
8 Department of Transportation, (2) any school bus, as defined in section  
9 14-275, or student transportation vehicle, as defined in section 14-212,  
10 when used for the transportation of children under the age of twenty-  
11 one years, (3) any school bus, as defined in section 14-275, when used  
12 for the transportation of passengers (A) by virtue of a contract with  
13 any public or private institution of higher education, (B) pursuant to a  
14 contract for service to a special event held at a location or facility  
15 which is not open for business on a daily basis throughout the year,

16 not to exceed a period of ten days, or (C) pursuant to a contract with a  
17 municipality for which the carrier provides school transportation  
18 service, [and] (4) any motor vehicle operated by or through a  
19 community-based regional transportation system for the elderly  
20 established pursuant to section 55 of public act 05-280\*, and (5) any  
21 motor vehicle operated by or through a community-based regional  
22 transportation system for the visually impaired.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

**Statement of Purpose:**

To exempt community-based regional transportation services for the visually impaired from livery license requirements.
