**AN ACT CONCERNING A PERSONAL INCOME TAX DEDUCTION FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO RECEIVE ALL APPROPRIATE HEALTH SCREENINGS AS RECOMMENDED BY THE AMERICAN MEDICAL ASSOCIATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-701 of the general statutes be amended to provide a
- 2 personal income tax deduction from adjusted gross income to any
- 3 individual who receives all age-appropriate health screenings and tests
- 4 as recommended by the American Medical Association. Such
- 5 deduction shall be limited to the aggregate cost of health care
- 6 insurance premiums and deductibles paid by the individual.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To permit a healthy living personal income tax deduction as a method of promoting proper preventive health care for residents.
