**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADDITION OF ENTRANCE AND EXIT
RAMPS ON THE MERRITT PARKWAY AND I-95 IN FAIRFIELD
COUNTY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds in accordance with sections 13b-74 to 13b-77,
- 3 inclusive, of the general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in
- 4 the aggregate fifty million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used
- 5 by the Department of Transportation for the purpose of adding
- 6 entrance and exit ramps at strategic points on the Merritt Parkway and
- 7 I-95 in Fairfield county, as determined by the Department of
- 8 Transportation, to maximize reduction in highway traffic congestion.

Statement of Purpose:

To fund construction of new exit and entrance ramps on the Merritt Parkway and I-95 in Fairfield county in order to reduce highway traffic congestion.
