AN ACT CONCERNING FISHING LICENSES FOR DISABLED VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 26-29b of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2010*):

3 No fee shall be charged for any hunting, sport fishing or trapping
4 license issued under this chapter to any physically disabled person,
5 and such license shall be a lifetime license not subject to the expiration
6 provisions of section 26-35. For the purposes of this section, a
7 "physically disabled person" [is] means (1) any person, including a
8 veteran of the armed forces, as defined in section 27-103, whose
9 disability consists of the loss of one or more limbs or the permanent
10 loss of the use of one or more limbs, and (2) any veteran of said armed
11 forces whose disability consists of the permanent impairment of the
12 use of any part or function of the body. A physically disabled person
13 shall submit to the commissioner a certification, signed by a licensed
14 physician, of such disability. No fee shall be charged for any hunting
15 or sport fishing license issued under this chapter to any physically
16 disabled person who is not a resident of this state if such person is a

17 resident of a state in which a physically disabled person from
18 Connecticut will not be required to pay a fee for a hunting or sport
19 fishing license, and such license shall be a lifetime license not subject to
20 the expiration provisions of section 26-35.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
