**AN ACT LIMITING THE INDEMNIFICATION OF FIRE SERVICE INSTRUCTORS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 7-323q of the general statutes is repealed and the  
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2010*):

3 The state shall save harmless and indemnify any person certified as  
4 a fire service instructor by the Commission on Fire Prevention and  
5 Control under section 7-323l from financial loss and expense, including  
6 legal fees and costs, if any, arising out of any claim, demand, suit or  
7 judgment by reason of alleged negligence or other act resulting in  
8 personal injury or property damage, which acts are not wanton,  
9 reckless or malicious, provided such person, at the time of the acts  
10 resulting in such injury or damage, was acting in the discharge of [his]  
11 such person's duties [in providing] (1) as an employee or member of a  
12 municipal, regional, state or tribal nation fire department to provide  
13 fire service training and instruction for the other members or  
14 employees of such municipal, regional, state or tribal nation fire  
15 department, or (2) as a fire service instructor employed by said  
16 commission to provide fire service training and instruction on behalf

17 of said commission.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	October 1, 2010	7-323q

**Statement of Purpose:**

To limit the indemnification of fire service instructors to those instructors who provide such training to their own municipal, regional, state or tribal nation fire department or while employed by the Commission on Fire Prevention and Control.
