AN ACT CONCERNING THE FILM TAX CREDIT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-217j of the general statutes be amended to lower the
- 2 threshold amount to qualify for the film tax credit from one million
- 3 dollars to five hundred thousand dollars, and to remove the
- 4 requirement that fifty per cent of principal photography occur in the
- 5 state if the company seeking the credit is involved in significant special
- 6 effects, post production or sound work on a film principally shot
- 7 elsewhere.

Statement of Purpose:

To make more state companies eligible for the film tax credit program.
