**AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF DAY CARE  
SUBSIDIES TO UNEMPLOYED WORKERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) No person eligible to receive
- 2 a child care subsidy pursuant to section 17b-749 of the general statutes
- 3 shall be denied such subsidy as a result of being deemed eligible to
- 4 receive benefits pursuant to chapter 567 of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow individuals who are eligible to receive unemployment compensation benefits to continue to receive child care subsidy benefits after losing their job so they are able to look for a new employment position.
