AN ACT CONCERNING A STATE-WIDE WATER USE PLAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Not later than October 1, 2011, the
2 Commissioners of Environmental Protection and Public Health, in
3 consultation with the Water Planning Council, established pursuant to
4 section 25-33o of the general statutes, shall develop a state-wide water
5 use plan. In developing such plan, said commissioners shall review
6 and consider, but not be limited to, any findings and recommendations
7 contained in the most recent reports developed pursuant to sections
8 25-33n to 25-33p, inclusive, of the general statutes and the content of
9 any water supply plan developed pursuant to section 25-32d of the
10 general statutes. Not later than January 1, 2012, such state-wide water
11 use plan shall be submitted, in accordance with the provisions of
12 section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committees of
13 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the
14 environment and public health.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
