**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ATTENDANCE OF REGISTERED
SEXUAL OFFENDERS AT SCHOOL FUNCTIONS INVOLVING THEIR
CHILDREN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2010*) Notwithstanding the
2 provisions of any local ordinance, any person required to register
3 under chapter 969 of the general statutes may enter in or upon the real
4 property comprising a public or private elementary or secondary
5 school to attend a school event or activity with his or her child or in
6 which his or her child is participating or to meet with school personnel
7 concerning his or her child.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To allow parents who are registered sexual offenders to attend events and meetings at their child's school that are of importance in their

child's life or that concern their child's education notwithstanding any local ordinance that might otherwise bar them from school property.
