**"AN ACT CONCERNING BILLING FOR SERVICES COVERED BY
LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE BY MANAGED RESIDENTIAL
COMMUNITIES."**

1 Strike lines 26 to 31, inclusive, in their entirety and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(7) Assist a resident who has a long-term care insurance policy with
4 preparing and submitting claims for benefits to the insurer, provided
5 such resident has executed a written authorization requesting and
6 directing the insurer to (A) disclose information to the managed
7 residential community relevant to such resident's eligibility for an
8 insurance benefit or payment, and (B) provide a copy of the acceptance
9 or declination of a claim for benefits to the managed residential
10 community at the same time such acceptance or declination is made to
11 such resident."

12 Strike lines 76 to 84, inclusive, in their entirety and substitute the
13 following in lieu thereof:

14 "(B) Each insurance company, fraternal benefit society, hospital
15 service corporation, medical service corporation or health care center
16 delivering, issuing for delivery, renewing, continuing or amending any
17 long-term care policy in this state shall, upon receipt of a written
18 authorization executed by the insured, (i) disclose information to a
19 managed residential community for the purpose of determining such
20 insured's eligibility for an insurance benefit or payment, and (ii)
21 provide a copy of the initial acceptance or declination of a claim for
22 benefits to the managed residential community at the same time such
23 acceptance or declination is made to the insured."

24 Strike lines 117 to 125, inclusive, in their entirety and substitute the
25 following in lieu thereof:

26 "(B) Each insurance company, fraternal benefit society, hospital
27 service corporation, medical service corporation or health care center
28 delivering, issuing for delivery, renewing, continuing or amending any
29 long-term care policy in this state shall, upon receipt of a written
30 authorization executed by the insured, (i) disclose information to a
31 managed residential community for the purpose of determining such
32 insured's eligibility for an insurance benefit or payment, and (ii)
33 provide a copy of the initial acceptance or declination of a claim for
34 benefits to the managed residential community at the same time such
35 acceptance or declination is made to the insured."
