“Back of the Budget” Language

**AN ACT MAKING ADJUSTMENTS TO STATE EXPENDITURES AND
REVENUES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2011.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 36 of public act 09-3 of the June special session is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
3 *passage*):

4 The unexpended balance of funds appropriated to the Office of
5 Policy and Management in section 43 of public act 08-1 of the January
6 special session for design and implementation of a comprehensive,
7 state-wide information technology system for the sharing of criminal
8 justice information and for costs related to the Criminal Justice
9 Information System Governing Board shall not lapse on June 30, 2009,
10 and such funds shall continue to be available for such purposes during
11 the fiscal [year] years ending June 30, 2010, and June 30, 2011.

12 Sec. 2. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The unexpended balance of funds

13 in the accounts Disproportionate Share - Medical Emergency
14 Assistance, DSH - Urban Hospitals in Distressed Municipalities and
15 Connecticut Children's Medical Center shall be transferred to
16 Medicaid Rates - Hospitals for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, for
17 the purpose of obtaining federal matching funds pursuant to
18 anticipated changes in federal law.

19 (b) The Commissioner of Social Services shall raise Medicaid
20 hospital rates in proportion to the amount of funds transferred
21 pursuant to subsection (a) of this section.

22 Sec. 3. Subsection (e) of section 4-85 of the 2010 supplement to the
23 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
24 thereof (*Effective from passage*):

25 (e) The provisions of this section shall not be construed to authorize
26 the Governor to reduce allotment requisitions or allotments in force
27 concerning (1) aid to municipalities; [or] (2) any budgeted agency of
28 the legislative or judicial branch, except that the Governor may require
29 an aggregate allotment reduction of a specified amount in accordance
30 with this section for the legislative or judicial branch, which shall be
31 achieved as determined by the Joint Committee on Legislative
32 Management or the Chief Court Administrator, as appropriate. The
33 joint committee or Chief Court Administrator, as appropriate, shall
34 submit reductions to the Governor through the Secretary of the Office
35 of Policy and Management not more than fifteen days after the
36 Governor requires such reductions; or (3) dues, fees or other payments
37 owed to any organization providing educational, research,
38 professional development or networking services or opportunities to
39 which the state or any state agency, as defined in section 4-37e, is a
40 member, except with the approval of the joint standing committee of
41 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
42 appropriations and the budgets of state agencies. The Governor,
43 through the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, shall
44 submit a recommendation for the reduction of an allotment requisition

45 or any allotment in force for such dues, fees or payments to said
46 committee. Not later than fifteen days after receipt of the
47 recommendation, the committee shall advise the secretary and
48 Governor of its approval or rejection of such recommendation. If the
49 committee does not act during such fifteen-day period, the
50 recommendation shall be deemed approved.

51 Sec. 4. (*Effective from passage*) In achieving the reductions specified in
52 section 11 of public act 09-3 of the June special session, as amended by
53 public act 09-7 of the September special session, for Reduce Other
54 Expenses to FY 07 Levels, reductions to the Other Expenses accounts of
55 the agencies specified in said section for the fiscal year ending June 30,
56 2011, shall be the same as or less than the reductions made to such
57 accounts under section 1 of public act 09-3 of the June special session,
58 as amended by public act 09-7 of the September special session, for
59 Reduce Other Expenses to FY 07 Levels for the fiscal year ending June
60 30, 2010.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
