Title: AN ACT AMENDING THE LIQUOR CONTROL ACT.

Statement of Purpose: To repeal the racquetball facility liquor permit, to allow institutions of higher education to manufacture or dispense wine at wine tasting and wine education classes, subject to applicable liquor control laws, to allow cafe liquor permit holders to open for business at 6 a.m. to serve breakfast, but not alcohol, to their customers and to permit tavern and cafe premises to remain open past normal hours for the purpose of motion picture filming, but not for the service of alcohol.
