Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE COLLECTION OF DNA.

Statement of Purpose: To transfer responsibility for the collection of DNA from sex offenders from the Department of Public Safety to the Court Support Services Division, to expand the offense of refusal to submit to such collection to include failure to submit, to make any failure or refusal to submit to DNA analysis a class D felony, to allow the Division of Scientific Services to approve the type of collection kits used to collect buccal samples and to add the Executive Director of the Court Support Services Division or a designee to the DNA Data Bank Oversight Panel.
