Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE REPORTING OF ADVERSE EVENTS AT HOSPITALS AND OUTPATIENT SURGICAL FACILITIES AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION RELATED TO PENDING COMPLAINTS FILED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH.

Statement of Purpose: To (1) require that the Department of Public Health's annual report to the General Assembly on adverse events include information that identifies the hospitals or outpatient surgical facilities where such adverse events occurred, (2) require the Department of Public Health to conduct annual random audits of hospitals and outpatient surgical facilities concerning adverse events and thereafter include information on such audits in its annual adverse events report, (3) provide employment protections to certain individuals who take action in furtherance of the adverse event reporting objectives, (4) provide the Commissioner of Public Health with authority to impose civil penalties against hospitals and outpatient surgical facilities, and (5) require that hospitals report annually on the rate of health care associated infections.
