Title: AN ACT CONCERNING TRUANCY.

Statement of Purpose: To require school districts making a referral to the court because of truancy problems to file such referral not later than fifteen days after a parent or person having control of a child who is truant fails to attend a meeting to discuss such truancy or otherwise fails to cooperate with the school attempting to solve such truancy problem; to require the State Board of Education to define "excused absence" and "unexcused absence" for uniformity in data collection and analysis in school district truancy problems; and to require the State Board of Education to report to the Governor and the General Assembly on truancy data and school district truancy programs.
