Title: AN ACT ENHANCING THE ABILITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE SERVICES TO COLLECT OUTSTANDING TAXES.

Statement of Purpose: To make certain changes increasing the ability of the Department of Revenue Services to collect outstanding taxes, including allowing the department, by regulation, to require license applicants to obtain a tax clearance from the department before being allowed to obtain a license, allowing the department to recoup its collections costs and attorney's fees when it is the prevailing party in a civil action brought in the courts of another state, and creating a "responsible person" concept for the trust taxes, i.e. sales and use tax, admissions and dues tax, motor vehicle fuels tax and employer withholding tax.
