**"AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL POSTEMPLOYMENT
BENEFIT PLAN DEFICIT FUNDING BONDS PILOT PROGRAM."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subdivision (19) of section 12-81 of the 2010 supplement to
4 the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
5 thereof (*Effective from passage and applicable to assessment years*
6 *commencing on or after October 1, 2010*):

7 (19) Subject to the provisions of sections 12-89, 12-90 and 12-95,
8 property to the amount of one thousand dollars belonging to, or held
9 in trust for, any resident of this state who (a) is a veteran of the armed
10 forces in service in time of war, (b) any resident of this state who was a
11 citizen of the United States at the time of his enlistment and who was
12 in the military or naval service of a government allied or associated
13 with that of the United States during the Second World War and
14 received an honorable discharge therefrom, (c) any resident of this
15 state who served during the Second World War as a member of any

16 armed force of any government signatory to the United Nations
17 Declaration of January 1, 1942, and participated in armed conflict with
18 an enemy of the United States and who has been a citizen of the United
19 States for at least ten years and presents satisfactory evidence of such
20 service, (d) any resident of this state who served as a member of the
21 crew of a merchant vessel during the Second World War and is
22 qualified with respect to such service as a member of the group known
23 as the "American Merchant Marine in ocean-going service during the
24 period of armed conflict, December 7, 1941, to August 15, 1945",
25 members of which are deemed to be eligible for certain veterans
26 benefits under a determination in the United States Department of
27 Defense, as recorded in the Federal Register of February 1, 1988,
28 provided such resident has received an armed forces discharge
29 certificate from the Department of Defense on the basis of such service,
30 (e) any member of the armed forces who was in service in time of war
31 and is still in the service and by reason of continuous service has not as
32 yet received a discharge, (f) any person who is retired from the armed
33 forces after thirty years of service because he has reached the age limit
34 prescribed by law or because he suffers from mental or physical
35 disability, [or] (g) any person who is serving in the armed services in
36 time of war, or (h) is a veteran of the armed forces who served on full-
37 time active duty for a period of one year or more during the period
38 from September 2, 1945, to December 26, 1991, and has been awarded
39 the Cold War Recognition Certificate; or lacking said amount of
40 property in his own name, so much of the property belonging to, or
41 held in trust for, his spouse, who is domiciled with him, as is necessary
42 to equal said amount. For the purposes of this subdivision, "veteran",
43 "armed forces" and "service in time of war" have the same meaning as
44 in section 27-103;"
