**"AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR THE JUDICIAL BRANCH."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (m) of section 51-44a of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*

5 *passage*):

6 (m) [In January of each year] On January 15, 2011, and annually  
7 thereafter, the chairperson of the commission shall report to the joint  
8 standing committee on judiciary the following information with  
9 respect to the prior calendar year: (1) The number of candidates  
10 interviewed for appointment as new nominees, the number of  
11 incumbent judges interviewed for reappointment to the same court  
12 and the number of incumbent judges interviewed for appointment to a  
13 different court, (2) the number of candidates who were recommended  
14 and denied recommendation to the Governor as new nominees, the  
15 number of incumbent judges recommended and denied  
16 recommendation for appointment to the same court and the number of  
17 incumbent judges recommended and denied recommendation for  
18 appointment to a different court, [and] (3) the statistics regarding the  
19 race, gender, national origin, religion and years of experience as  
20 members of the bar of all such candidates and incumbent judges  
21 interviewed, recommended and denied recommendation under  
22 subdivisions (1) and (2) of this subsection, and (4) as of January first in  
23 the year of such report, the number of candidates on the list compiled  
24 by the commission pursuant to subsection (f) of this section and the  
25 statistics regarding the race, gender, national origin, religion, years of  
26 experience as members of the bar and calendar year of  
27 recommendation of all such candidates."
