"AN ACT AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF RESIDENT STUDENTS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) Notwithstanding the provisions
4 of subsection (m) of section 10-145b of the general statutes, for the
5 school year commencing July 1, 2010, those teachers (1) who began in a
6 beginning educator program, pursuant to section 10-145b of the
7 general statutes, revision of 1958, revised to January 1, 2009, but have
8 not completed that program as of July 1, 2009, and participate in the
9 teacher education and mentoring program, pursuant to section 10-145o
10 of the general statutes, as amended by this act, during the 2010-2011
11 school year, (2) who are not eligible for a provisional educator
12 certificate because such teachers have not completed the teacher
13 education and mentoring program, and (3) whose initial educator

14 certificate is due to be renewed, shall not be responsible for paying the
15 State Board of Education the nonreturnable fee of two hundred dollars
16 for reissuance of such teacher's initial educator certificate.

17 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (m) of section 10-
18 145b of the general statutes, for the school year commencing July 1,
19 2010, those teachers (1) who began in a beginning educator program,
20 pursuant to section 10-145b of the general statutes, revision of 1958,
21 revised to January 1, 2009, but have not completed that program as of
22 July 1, 2009, and participate in the teacher education and mentoring
23 program, pursuant to section 10-145o of the general statutes, as
24 amended by this act, during the 2010-2011 school year, (2) who are not
25 eligible for a provisional educator certificate because such teachers
26 have not completed the teacher education and mentoring program,
27 and (3) who have renewed their initial educator certificates prior to the
28 effective date of this section, shall pay to the State Board of Education a
29 nonreturnable fee of seventy-five dollars for a provisional educator
30 certificate upon completion of the teacher education and mentoring
31 program.

32 Sec. 502. Subsection (g) of section 10-145o of the 2010 supplement to
33 the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
34 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2010*):

35 (g) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (h) of this section,
36 for the school year commencing July 1, 2010, beginning teachers who
37 hold an initial educator certificate and have not participated in any
38 beginning educator program as of July 1, 2009, shall participate in the
39 teacher education and mentoring programs as follows:

40 (1) Beginning teachers in the following subject areas and
41 endorsement areas shall be required to successfully complete the
42 teacher education and mentoring program in full: Elementary
43 education, English and language arts, mathematics, science, social
44 studies, special education, bilingual education, music, physical
45 education, visual arts, health, world languages and teachers of English

46 as a second language.

47 (2) Beginning teachers in any other endorsement area and whose
48 primary function is providing direct instruction to students shall be
49 required to successfully complete one year of mentorship and two
50 instructional modules."
