1 Strike lines 48 and 49 in their entirety and insert the following in
2 lieu thereof: "general statutes. Not later than November 1, 2010, the
3 executive director shall attempt to notify all individual lottery sales
4 agents of"

5 In line 50, after "program." insert the following: "Such notification
6 shall include, but not be limited to, publication of a notice concerning
7 such program in a newspaper having general circulation in the state
8 and on the division's Internet web site."

9 In line 53, after "shall" insert ", not later than December 31, 2010,
10 notify the Division of Special Revenue of such agent's intent to
11 participate in the program. Such agent shall"

12 Strike lines 54 and 55 and insert the following in lieu thereof: "of the
13 division's receipt of such agent's notice of intent to participate in

14 accordance with this subsection to pay in full the amount owed,
15 minus"

16 In line 65, strike "within sixty days" and insert in lieu thereof "not
17 later than sixty days after the date the division received notification of
18 such agent's intent to participate"

19 Strike lines 70 and 71 in their entirety and insert the following in
20 lieu thereof:

21 "(d) The executive director shall transfer all moneys collected from
22 the settlement initiative program to the Connecticut Lottery
23 Corporation, provided the division may retain a portion of such
24 moneys in an amount equal to the administrative expenses incurred by
25 the division to administer the program. The Connecticut Lottery
26 Corporation shall transfer such moneys to the General Fund in
27 accordance with subsection (c) of section 12-812 of the general
28 statutes."
