**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PRESERVATION AND CREATION OF  
JOBS IN CONNECTICUT."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2010*) The sum of \$9,000,000, exclusive of  
4 assessments, shall be transferred from the Banking Fund, established  
5 under section 36a-65 of the general statutes, and credited to the  
6 resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.

7 Sec. 2. Section 126 of public act 09-3 of the June special session, as  
8 amended by section 41 of public act 09-8 of the September special  
9 session and section 15 of public act 10-3, is amended to read as follows  
10 (*Effective July 1, 2010*):

11 (a) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Comptroller shall  
12 transfer the sum of seventy-one million two hundred thousand dollars

13 from the resources of the General Fund to the Special Transportation  
14 Fund.

15 (b) For the fiscal [years] year ending June 30, 2011, [and June 30,  
16 2012,] the Comptroller shall transfer the sum of [one hundred twenty-  
17 four million fifty thousand] one hundred eight million fifty thousand  
18 dollars from the resources of the General Fund to the Special  
19 Transportation Fund.

20 (c) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, the Comptroller shall  
21 transfer the sum of one hundred twenty-six million dollars from the  
22 resources of the General Fund to the Special Transportation Fund.

23 [(c)] (d) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, and annually  
24 thereafter, the Comptroller shall transfer the sum of one hundred  
25 seventy-two million eight hundred thousand dollars from the  
26 resources of the General Fund to the Special Transportation Fund.

27 Sec. 3. (*Effective July 1, 2010*) Notwithstanding the provisions of  
28 section 19a-32e of the general statutes, the sum of \$5,000,000 shall be  
29 transferred from the Stem Cell Research Fund and credited to the  
30 resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.

31 Sec. 4. (*Effective July 1, 2010*) Notwithstanding the provisions of  
32 section 15-155 of the general statutes, the sum of \$1,200,000 shall be  
33 transferred from the boating account and credited to the resources of  
34 the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.

35 Sec. 5. Section 12-284b of the general statutes is repealed. (*Effective*  
36 *July 1, 2010, and applicable to income years commencing on or after January*  
37 *1, 2010*)"
