**"AN ACT CONCERNING REPORTING BY STATE AGENCIES."**

1 Strike lines 1 to 24, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The State Comptroller, or the  
4 State Comptroller's designee, in consultation with the director of the  
5 legislative Office of Fiscal Analysis, or the director's designee, and the  
6 Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, or the secretary's  
7 designee, shall develop a plan to develop the functionality of the  
8 CORE-CT system and other information technology systems used by  
9 state agencies to facilitate program reporting of all state receipts and  
10 disbursements. Such plan shall include the means by which (1) state  
11 agencies shall enter information for purposes of such categorization  
12 into the CORE-CT system and keep the information updated, which  
13 may include the use of computer format codes, (2) such data shall be  
14 retrievable, (3) state agencies that do not utilize the CORE-CT system  
15 for their primary financial management and reporting system shall

16 provide data from their current information technology system, and  
17 (4) the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management shall provide  
18 to the legislative Office of Fiscal Analysis an electronic version of all  
19 data generated by the CORE-CT and other information technology  
20 systems that are used to prepare the budget document transmitted to  
21 the General Assembly in accordance with section 4-71 of the general  
22 statutes. On or before January 1, 2011, the State Comptroller, the  
23 director of the legislative Office of Fiscal Analysis and the Secretary of  
24 the Office of Policy and Management shall jointly submit a report, in  
25 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,  
26 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having  
27 cognizance of matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of  
28 state agencies on the plan. Such report shall include a summary of the  
29 plan and the estimated date by which the plan will be fully  
30 implemented."
