**"AN ACT CONCERNING EXPEDITED PARTNER THERAPY FOR SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED DISEASES."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2010*) Any entity that conducts  
4 a blood drive in this state shall ensure that a nurse, licensed in  
5 accordance with the provisions of chapter 378 of the general statutes, is  
6 on-site at the location where such blood drive occurs for the entire  
7 duration of the blood drive. A licensed nurse designated as the  
8 supervisor of any blood drive where apheresis collections occur shall  
9 be trained in apheresis collection procedures and oversee no more than  
10 three workers performing apheresis procedures in accordance with all  
11 applicable federal Food and Drug Administration and AABB  
12 standards. For purposes of this section, "AABB" means the  
13 organization formerly known as the American Association of Blood  
14 Banks."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>October 1, 2010</i>	New section
