"AN ACT CONCERNING EXPEDITED PARTNER THERAPY FOR SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED DISEASES."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (Effective October 1, 2010) (a) As used in this
4 section:

5 (1) "AABB" means the organization formerly known as the
6 American Association of Blood Banks;

7 (2) "Blood collection technician" means a person who is trained in
8 accordance with all applicable Food and Drug Administration and
9 AABB professional standards and who meets all AABB professional
10 competency requirements; and

11 (3) "Licensed nurse" means a nurse licensed in accordance with the
12 provisions of chapter 378 of the general statutes.

13 (b) Any entity that conducts a blood drive in this state shall ensure
14 that a licensed nurse is on-site at the location where such blood drive
15 occurs for the entire duration of the blood drive.

16 (c) A blood collection technician may operate blood or blood
17 component collection apheresis equipment under the supervision of a
18 licensed nurse. Each licensed nurse designated as the supervisor of any
19 blood drive where apheresis collections occur shall be trained in
20 apheresis collection procedures and oversee not more than three blood
21 collection technicians performing apheresis collection procedures in
22 accordance with all applicable federal Food and Drug Administration
23 and AABB standards."
