"AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS TO THE EDUCATION STATUTES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subdivision (22) of section 10-262f of the 2010 supplement
4 to the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in
5 lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2010*):

6 (22) "Resident students" means the number of pupils of the town
7 enrolled in public schools at the expense of the town on [October first]
8 January fifteenth or the full school day immediately preceding such
9 date, provided the number shall be decreased by the Department of
10 Education for failure to comply with the provisions of section 10-16
11 and shall be increased by one one-hundred-eightieth for each full-time
12 equivalent school day in the school year immediately preceding such
13 date of at least five hours of actual school work in excess of one
14 hundred eighty days and nine hundred hours of actual school work

15 and be increased by the full-time equivalent number of such pupils
16 attending the summer sessions immediately preceding such date at the
17 expense of the town; "enrolled" shall include pupils who are scheduled
18 for vacation on the above date and who are expected to return to
19 school as scheduled. Pupils participating in the program established
20 pursuant to section 10-266aa shall be counted in accordance with the
21 provisions of subsection (h) of section 10-266aa."
