- 1 Change the effective date of section 1 to "Effective July 1, 2010"
- 2 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
3 internal references accordingly:
- 4 "Sec. 501. Subparagraph (B) of subdivision (2) of subsection (f) of  
5 section 17 of emergency certified bill 493 of the current session, as  
6 amended by Senate amendment schedule "A", is repealed and the  
7 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2010*):
- 8 (B) For door-to-door sales to customers with a maximum demand of  
9 one hundred kilowatts, which shall include the sale of electric  
10 generation services in which the electric supplier, aggregator or agent  
11 of an electric supplier or aggregator solicits the sale and receives the

12 customer's agreement or offer to purchase at a place other than the  
13 seller's place of business, be conducted (i) in accordance with any  
14 municipal and local ordinances regarding door-to-door solicitations,  
15 (ii) between the hours of ten o'clock a.m. and six o'clock p.m., and (iii)  
16 with both Spanish and English written materials available. Any  
17 representative of an electric supplier, aggregator or agent of an electric  
18 supplier or aggregator shall prominently display or wear a photo  
19 identification badge stating the name of such person's employer or the  
20 electric supplier the person represents. Each such supplier, aggregator  
21 or agent shall conduct a criminal background check on each person  
22 such entity employs to conduct such door-to-door sales. [and no one  
23 who has been convicted of a felony or a misdemeanor involving  
24 robbery, theft, misrepresentation or any other similar crime shall be  
25 employed to conduct such sales.]"
