

## Testimony

Hello members of the Appropriations Committee: Thank you for taking the time to listen to a very concerned student. My name is Shakeela Edwards and I am a student at Naugatuck Valley Community College. Although it is my first year as a college student, I have known and loved that campus since the summer of 2006 when I enrolled in the ConnCAP program. In five years, many great programs, services and activities have been added to the college to enhance student performance and overall success rate. Some of these services include the Academic Center for Excellence, where students come and receive tutoring in several subjects, all free to current students. The Advising and Counseling Center also supports students and helps us plan map out our success. Budget cuts will greatly impact the growing success of these programs and negatively impact students attending Naugatuck Valley Community College.

While in high school, funding from the college made it possible for me to receive the Presidential Scholarship from Naugatuck Valley Community College. I was a part of the Dual Enrollment Partnerships program which allowed me to take college courses while still in high school. If NVCC's funding is cut, other students will not have the same opportunity I had.
