The Committee on Environment reported through REP. ROY of the 119th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING WATER TABLE CONTAMINATION IN THE TOWN OF DURHAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Not later than February 1, 2012, the
2 Department of Environmental Protection, in accordance with the
3 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, shall submit a report
4 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
5 cognizance of matters relating to the environment on the efforts by
6 said department to understand, analyze and act on the contamination
7 of the water table in the town of Durham. Such report shall include,
8 but not be limited to, a description of the causes and extent of such
9 contamination, the effects of such contamination, options for resolving
10 any negative effect caused by such contamination, the department's
11 recommended options, the reasons for such recommendations and a
12 proposed timeline for the implementation of such recommended
13 options.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
